"Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God." Hebrews 12:1-2

Trinity Lutheran Scholarship

Trinity Lutheran Church in Vinton has a scholarship fund for anyone in the Benton Circuit who is attending, or will be attending a LCMS college or seminary and plans to serve in the LCMS as a full-time worker. The application is available in the office at St. John. Application must be returned by July 1st for the first semester and by November 1st for the second semester. The amount of aid to be awarded will be determined by the monies available in the Student Aid fund, divided by the number of eligible applicants, not to exceed \$250 per applicant, per semester or \$500 per year.

ILSTO Update

Fourteen LCMS schools of Iowa have come together to form the Iowa Lutheran School Tuition Organization. Anyone who pays Iowa state income tax can donate and receive the tax benefits. The benefits to the donor are:

- Seeing more children able to attend our Lutheran schools that they may have Jesus in their lives every day.
- Knowing families may not be struggling quite so much because of increasing tuition rates and their commitment to sending their children to a participating Lutheran School.
- 75% tax credit on lowa income tax. That means if you could donate \$1000, you'd receive a \$750 tax reduction on your lowa income taxes.
